In the year 2017-18 college has taken feedback in the form of feedback form. Following is the analysis done on the basis of 34 feedback forms.

Q -1. How much of the syllabus was taught in class?

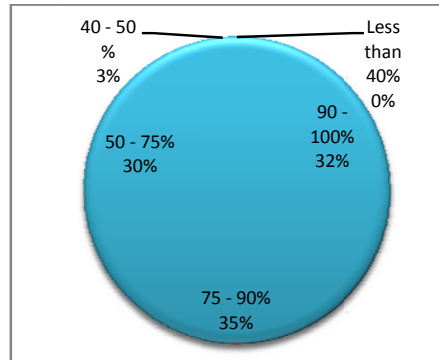


Figure – 1 Syllabus

Figure – 1 represents response given by students for Q – 1. Here 32% of the students say that 90-100% syllabus has been taught in class, 35% students say that 75 – 90 % syllabus has been taught in the class.

Q-2. What is your opinion about the library holdings for the course?

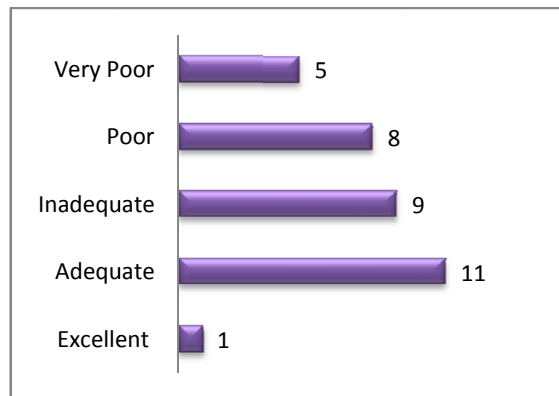


Figure – 2 Opinion about the library

Figure – 2 represents response given by students for Q -2. Here out of 34 students, 11 students say that there was Adequate library holdings for the course, 9 students says that there was Inadequate facility for library holdings for the course, 8 students tell us poor facility for library holdings for the course.

Q -3. Were you able to get the prescribed readings?

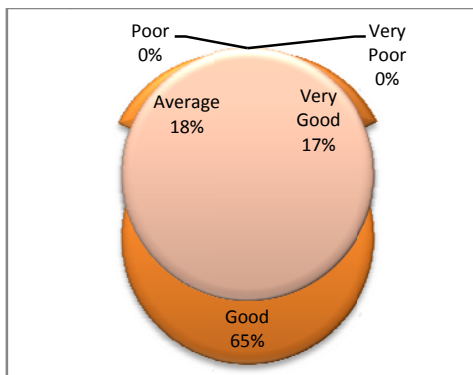


Figure – 3 prescribed reading

Figure -3 represents response given by students for Q – 3. 17% students says that they are getting “Very Good” facility for prescribed readings, 65% students says that they able to get “Good” Prescribed readings, 18% says they get average prescribed readings.

Q -4. The Internal Evaluation system as it exists is

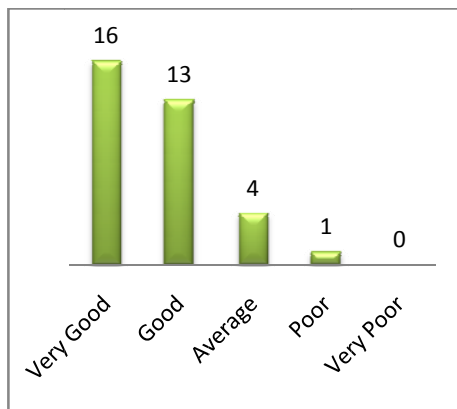


Figure – 4 Internal Evaluation System

Q – 5. How do you rate the student – teacher relationship in the college as a whole?

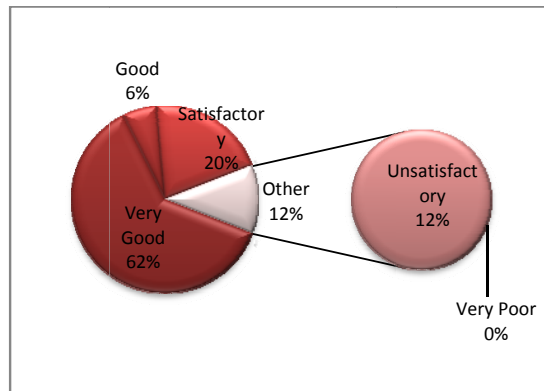


Figure – 5 Student – Teacher Relationship

Q – 7. How do you find the college administrative offices?

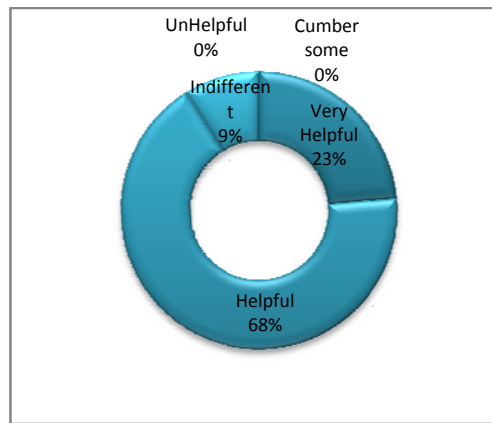


Figure – 6 College Administrative Offices

Q – 8. How do you rate the health care facilities?

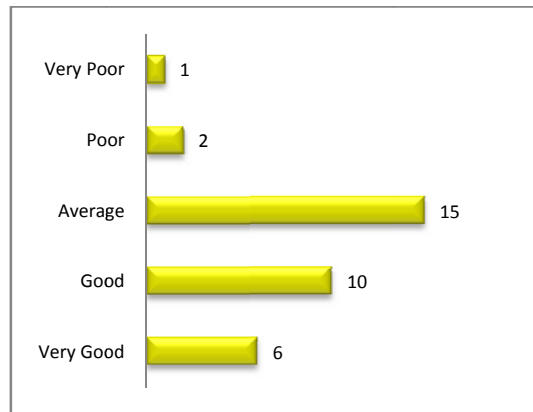


Figure – 7 Health care facilities

Q – 9. Did you participate in any of the extra-curricular activities of the Department/College?

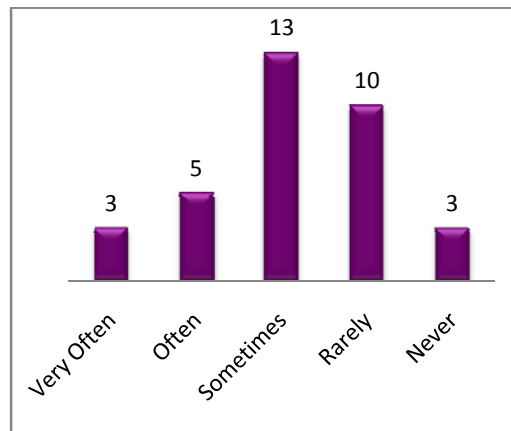


Figure – 8 Extra-Curricular Activities in the College

Q – 10. What was the attitude of teachers to extra-curricular activities?

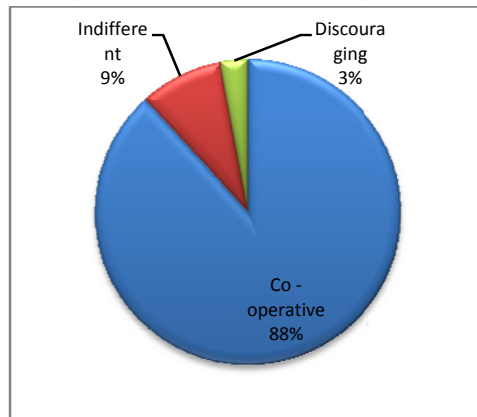


Figure – 9 Attitude of teachers to extra – Curricular Activities

Q – 11. Has your time at the college been intellectually enriching?

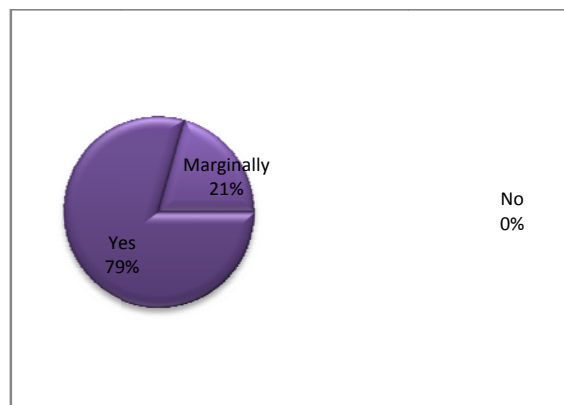


Figure – 10 Time at college been intellectually enriching

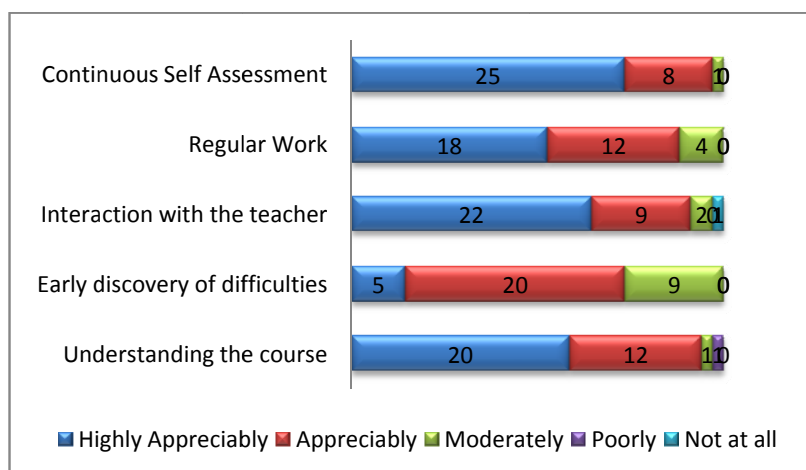


Figure – 11 Internal Assessment System

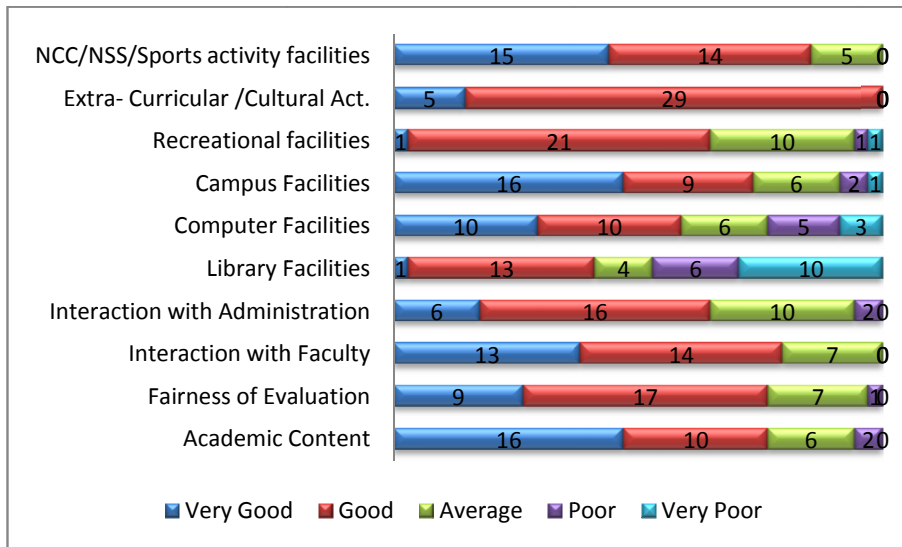


Figure – 12 Overall Rating of the Program
