

# BETI BACHAO , BETI PADHAO

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TODAY, I would like to raise the burning issue of women's condition in our society through my this article.

First I would like to share with you a nice line regarding a girl child.

“Make a girl child power of the family, society and country and not the burden, weakness and helpless entity of the family, society and country”.

According to 2011 census report, sex ratio was 940 female per 1000 male and between 0 to 6 yrs girls and boys ratio was left around 919 girls per 1000 boys. This ratio was the lowest in Haryana state, 877 girls per 1000 boys. The continuous decrease in number of girl child is a very dangerous sign. It happened so because of some bad practices against them such as predetermination of sex and sex selective abortions. Girls should be treated equal to boys and should get equal opportunities to do work like a boy. It should be noted that “ If you kill a girl, you kill a mother of tomorrow”.

Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao was launched by P.M Modiji on 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2015 at Panipat, Haryana. It is an effective campaign to save the girl child and educate the girl child all over India.
